Nestled in a valley of irrigated orchards, the Apple Bowl is a mecca for athletes and fans alike with its electric atmosphere and versatility. In addition to serving as the home for our very own Okanagan Sun Football Club, the bowl has also played host to numerous national and international sporting events. The Apple Bowl has a rich soccer history, hosting many national finals and its latest honours include the U-23 Men's Olympic qualifier, Canada vs. El Salvador and the U14 & U18 Friendly Game between Team Canada and Team New Zealand.



The Apple Bowl is equipped to seat 1,054 within the covered grandstand and an additional 1260 with 9 aluminum bleachers on the east side of the stadium. For larger events in the stadium there is ample room on the north and south ends of the field to accommodate additional portable bleachers. The stadium includes 4 dressing rooms, concession stand, permanent restrooms and a fully equipped sound booth and sound system. A covered press box is equipped to host all print, radio and television personnel covering Apple Bowl action.



The Apple Bowl is also home to the Kelowna Track & Field Club and the Annual Jack Brow Memorial Track Meet which hosts over 1,500 athletes. The Apple Bowl has also been host to the B.C. Summer Games and the B.C. 2000 Seniors Games. This facility meets the recognized IAAF Standards as outlined in the IAAF Handbook and IAAF facilities manual. The track surface is a rubberized asphalt (spike length 5mm) and has 8 lanes. The Apple Bowl also has high jump, pole vault, long/triple jump, shot put, discus, hammer throw and javelin throw areas.



General Information:

- 1555 Burtch Rd, Kelowna, B.C.
- A Liquor Primary License has been established with an approved contractor. Functions requesting liquor service are required to operate through the licensed concession contractor. A Special Occasions license will not be considered within this facility.
- Very high quality Sportsfield lighting (level 3 standard). Lights are computer controlled.

Getting There:

Via: Highway 97 (Harvey Avenue)

Eastbound from Lake Okanagan Bridge – Turn left on Burtch Rd. The facility is accessed via the Parking Lot at Dr. Knox Middle School.

Via: Northbound from Winfield – Turn right on Burtch Rd. The facility is accessed via the Parking Lot at Dr. Knox Middle School.

Parking:

- There is ample angle parking for this facility in the following locations:
- 450 parking spots at the Parkinson Recreation Centre which is directly south of the Apple Bowl.
 - 150 parking spots at Dr. Knox Middle School
 - 150 spots available north southwest of the Apple bowl adjacent to the tennis courts
