SPALL ROAD TRAFFIC DISRUPTION **SUNDAY DECEMBER 3**

Spall Road, between Bernard Avenue and Highway 97, will be reduced to single lane traffic north and southbound on Sunday December 3 between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. to accommodate the installation of railway crossing barriers.

Traffic personnel will be on site directing motorists and will make every effort to minimize disruptions; however, motorists are asked to drive with extreme caution and observe the posted construction speed limit or to take alternate routes to avoid delays.

This work will allow tie-in of the Central Okanagan Bypass, a new four lane road that runs from High Road (east of Bankhead Elementary and Lombardy Park parallel to the railway tracks) to a new intersection at Spall Road. The \$8.4 million construction contract was awarded to Hayter Construction Ltd. The road is scheduled to open in mid-December, weather permitting.
