Re: Central Okanagan Bypass – Project Update

The Central Okanagan Bypass is scheduled to open to motorists on December 15, 2006. Construction will continue on sidewalks and landscaping as weather permits. Initially, the road will accommodate single lane traffic in either direction until completion in spring of 2007.

A drawing has been attached illustrating the new traffic pattern changes as well as the remaining works and future Rails with Trails. In addition, the drawing includes the current state of sidewalks, traffic signals, plus new and future pedestrian signals. Signage will be in place along pedestrian walkways under construction and “Share the Road” signs for cyclists will be posted until the Rail with Trails project is complete.

The City will be encouraging safe driving through a press release and informing motorists to drive responsibly by obeying posted speed limits and traffic devices.
