SPALL ROAD AND CLEMENT AVENUE PAVING

On Tuesday May 8 the top lift of pavement will be placed at the intersection of Spall Road and Clement Avenue. Spall Road southbound will be restricted to one lane between Bernard Avenue and Enterprise Way from 9 a.m. until 3 p.m.

The traffic signals located at the railway tracks at this intersection will be temporarily disabled impacting:

- northbound left turns
- southbound right turns, and
- eastbound left turn traffic.

Traffic control personnel will be at the intersection, however drivers are urged to use extra care and attention while the signal lights are out of operation.

Paving of Clement Avenue, between Spall Road and Gordon Drive, will begin on Wednesday May 9 and continue until Friday May 18. Work will only take place between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. East and westbound traffic will be moved from one side of the road to the other as paving proceeds.

Traffic control personnel will be on site directing traffic throughout the paving project. Motorists are encouraged to use Highway 97 to avoid delays.

It is expected the Clement Avenue extension will be in full operation by the end of May with medians in place and only landscaping remaining.

The \$8.5 million contract with Hayter Construction Ltd. covers the four lane extension of Clement Avenue from Gordon Drive to Spall Road, an important link in the City's transportation network.
