As part of this year's construction program, I am pleased to inform you the City of Kelowna will be constructing the Cawston Avenue Multi-use Corridor. The multi-use corridor will provide a safe and convenient off-road pathway connection from Rails with Trails to the downtown waterfront and Cultural District.

Utility upgrades on Cawston Avenue, from Water Street to Gordon Drive and Ethel Street, from Cawston Avenue to Weddel Place will be completed in conjunction with this project.

Construction is scheduled to begin in July with completion by November 2010. The construction contract will be awarded in June.
