The City of Kelowna and consultant, Urban Systems Ltd., invite you to attend an open house regarding the design for the Cawston Avenue Multi-use Corridor.

**Wednesday, September 16, 2009**  
**4 p.m. to 7 p.m.**  
**Kelowna Curling Club Foyer, 551 Recreation Avenue**

The proposed corridor will provide a safe and convenient off-road pathway connection from Rails with Trails to the downtown waterfront and Cultural District. Extending 1400 metres, the pathway will begin at High Road, to Pheasant Street, and then extend along Cawston Avenue to Water Street. The \$3 million project's design will be completed this year with construction scheduled for next spring.

Features and benefits include:

- 4-metre wide off-road walking/cycling corridor
- Pedestrian crossing signals and crosswalks
- Curbs and gutters (urbanized) along Cawston Avenue
- Traffic calming features such as traffic circle, chicanes, bulb-outs, raised intersections resulting in less speeding and less traffic volume
- Wide boulevard with the possibility of community gardening
