Open house for Cawston Avenue multi-use corridor

Displays of the Cawston Avenue multi-use corridor alignment and facilities for pedestrians and cyclists will be available for viewing at an open house Wednesday, September 16 from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. at the Kelowna Curling Club, 551 Recreation Avenue.

The City and its consultant are developing a design for the off-road path along High Road, Pheasant Street and Cawston Avenue to the waterfront. Residents are invited to share their comments to help shape the final design for the multi-use corridor.

Construction of the multi-use corridor is expected to begin in 2010.
