Re: Cawston Avenue Multi-Use Corridor - Pheasant Street Residents' Meeting

More than 100 residents attended the open house September 16 to view the design plans and speak with staff regarding the proposed Cawston Avenue Multi-Use Corridor.

This multi-use corridor is one of three in the city that is being planned for construction in 2010. The 1400 metre off-road pathway is proposed to begin at High Road, to Pheasant Street, and then extend along Cawston Avenue to Water Street. The off-road pathway will offer many functional and aesthetic improvements and provide alternate mobility options.

During the open house, residents were enthusiastic about the improvements; however, concerns were expressed with the loss of parking.

With the potential parking loss along Pheasant Street, I would like to take this opportunity to meet with you and your neighbours to discuss this issue further and review options for consideration.
