Re: Open House – Gordon Drive Transportation Improvements

The transportation improvements on Gordon Drive between Mission Creek Bridge and Lanfranco Road have been approved by City Council and will be constructed over the next two years.

The widening of Gordon Drive between Cook and Lanfranco Roads as well as the construction of an off-road multi-use pathway will be completed this fall (Phase 1). The replacement of Gordon Drive Bridge is scheduled to take place in 2010 which will see the closure of Gordon Drive at the bridge during the summer (Phase 2). Provisions will be made to detour traffic.

The purpose of the upgrade is to improve capacity and operations as part of the Official Community Plan and 2020 Transportation Road Network Plan.

A traffic management plan for phase one will be in place prior to construction, signage will be installed to ensure limited impact to commuter traffic. Local traffic will experience delays during active construction and pedestrian traffic may experience minor inconveniences.
