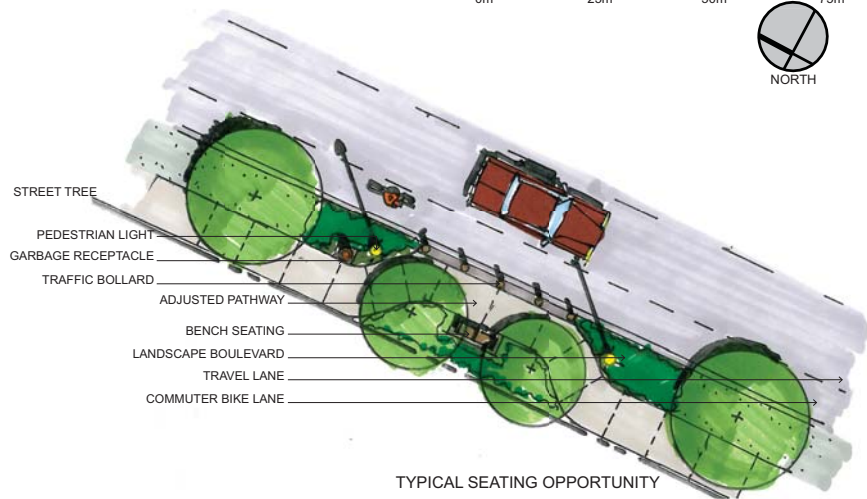


**Design Principles**

The design team, with input from City of Kelowna staff and the general public have created a multi-use corridor that we believe will be highly coveted by the community.

The design proposal features include;

- Extends the existing pedestrian walkway from Gyro Park to Rotary Park and beyond to the heart of the tourist area at Cook Road.
- A wide smooth hard surface walkway that accommodates all ages and abilities including youth, seniors, families and mobility challenged.
- The provision of safe and efficient transportation routing for all modes of transportation (pedestrians, cyclists, public transit and auto's).
- Establishes "Urban Braille" standards for the provision of a system of tactile information serving the needs of the visually impaired.
- Addresses the City's commitment to a sustainable design environment through the consideration of increasing the tree canopy, water wise plantings, maintenance conscience design, the use of recycled materials, and permeable paving.
