Transportation design standards in the SDS Bylaw are being updated which guides the design and construction of infrastructure in Kelowna. The updated section includes more contextual guidelines reflecting how and where the City is growing, with better consideration of land use context, added sections to support sustainable transportation options, a greater focus on safety, and updated street cross sections. These changes align with the City's transportation goals and objectives while supporting continued growth.
