## \$35 Rain Sensor Rebate Form

### 1. Eligibility

Commercial or residential properties connected to the City of Kelowna Water Utility system or who currently have SEKID as their water purveyor, are eligible for this rebate. Properties served by private wells or utilities, other improvement districts (e.g. Rutland Water Works, BMID, GEID) do not qualify. The program is funded only for those connected or scheduled to be connected, to the City of Kelowna Water Utility.

Applicants must have purchased and installed an approved rain sensor that can be program to work with irrigation controllers and provide specific days of the week. There is a maximum of one (1) rebate per installation address.

Applicants must have a sales receipt dated between April 19, 2019 and Aug. 30, 2019 and must attach a copy of a Kelowna Water Utility bill that clearly shows the property address, account number and is dated within the past six months.

Be sure to attach all required documents. Rebate cheques will be issued to registered owners only.
