About Cameron House



This house was the home of William Alister Cameron and Sophie Cameron between 1928 and 1982.

Alister and Sophie were married in 1928, the year the Cameron House was built. Sophie was a native of Scotland and arrived in Canada only a few years prior to her marriage to Alister. They raised their family in the log house.

Alister lived there until his death in 1970 and Sophie remained until 1982.

A portion of the land was purchased by the City in 1976. The remainder of the original property was donated to the City as park land after Sophie died.

HERITAGE VALUE



The heritage value of the Cameron House is due in part to its association with a prominent family with interests in ranching, civil engineering, and youth activities in the early years of the community.

The building is valued for its architecture, a log building, rare in Kelowna, in an attractive park setting on the former Guisachan estate. The house today is a recognized community landmark and is listed on the City of Kelowna Heritage Register.
