

Prohibited Items

Kelowna Memorial Park Cemetery is a public park.

Guidelines for what can and cannot be placed help maintain the park's beauty and ensure the safety of visitors, staff, and wildlife. The Cemetery accepts no responsibility or liability for any items that are lost, stolen or removed by an act of vandalism.

Prohibited items throughout Cemetery grounds

Items below are always prohibited in all sections:

- Glass
- Ceramics
- Breakable items
- Balloons
- Stickers
- Candles and other fire hazards
- Lighting including solar lights

Permanent vases throughout Cemetery grounds

Select items below are allowed in granite vases affixed to upright monuments and bronze vases affixed to cremation niche shutters.

- Live and artificial flowers allowed
- Flowers cannot overhang onto other plots

Grassed areas

Select items below are allowed by season.

Summer (March 14 – October 31)

- Live flowers permitted in in-ground vases
- Potted plants prohibited
- Artificial flowers prohibited
- Cellophane prohibited
- Any other items prohibited

Winter (November 1 – March 1)

- Potted plants in non-breakable pot
- Live or artificial flowers
- Wreaths
- Wood or metal decorations
- All adornments must be contained within the boundaries of the plot or shutter

Pioneer Sections A & B

Select items below are allowed year-round.

- Live and artificial flowers in a permanent vase.
- Above ground vases made of granite, stone, or bronze that are affixed to the plot.
- In-ground vases may be any material
- Monuments and plot modifications must be approved by the Cemetery office.
