

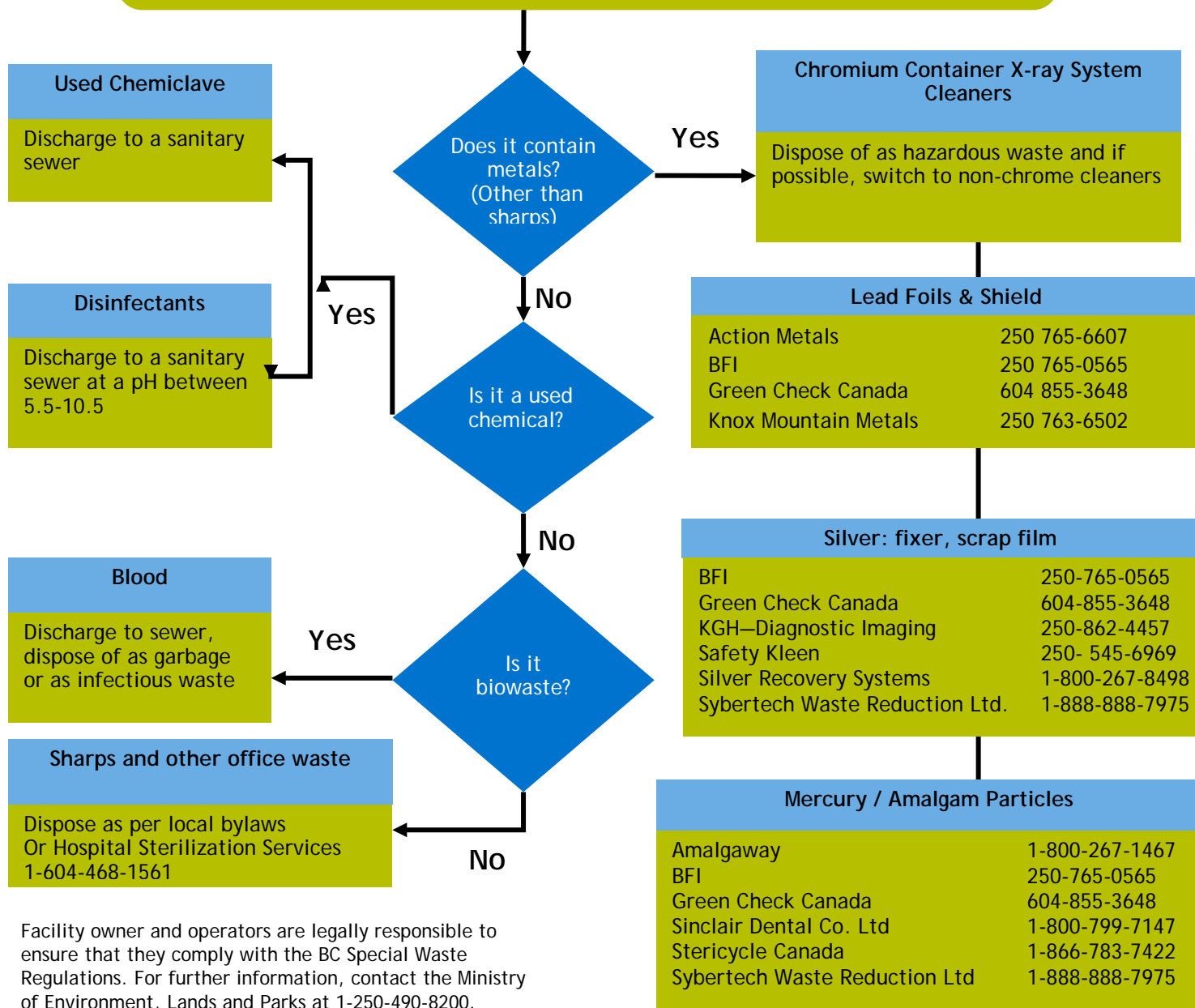
# Dental Office Waste Management Guide



Dental wastes are potentially harmful to the environment and require special storage and disposal. These wastes must be collected for proper disposal, treatment or recycling following the correct protocols listed below:

## Dental Waste Items:

- Amalgam Particles
- Blood (liquid, dried, or dripping)
- Chemiclave Chemicals
- Chromium Container X-Ray System Cleaners
- Disinfectants
- Fixer (developer or scrap film)
- Lead Foils and Shield
- Sharp Objects
- Waste Mercury
