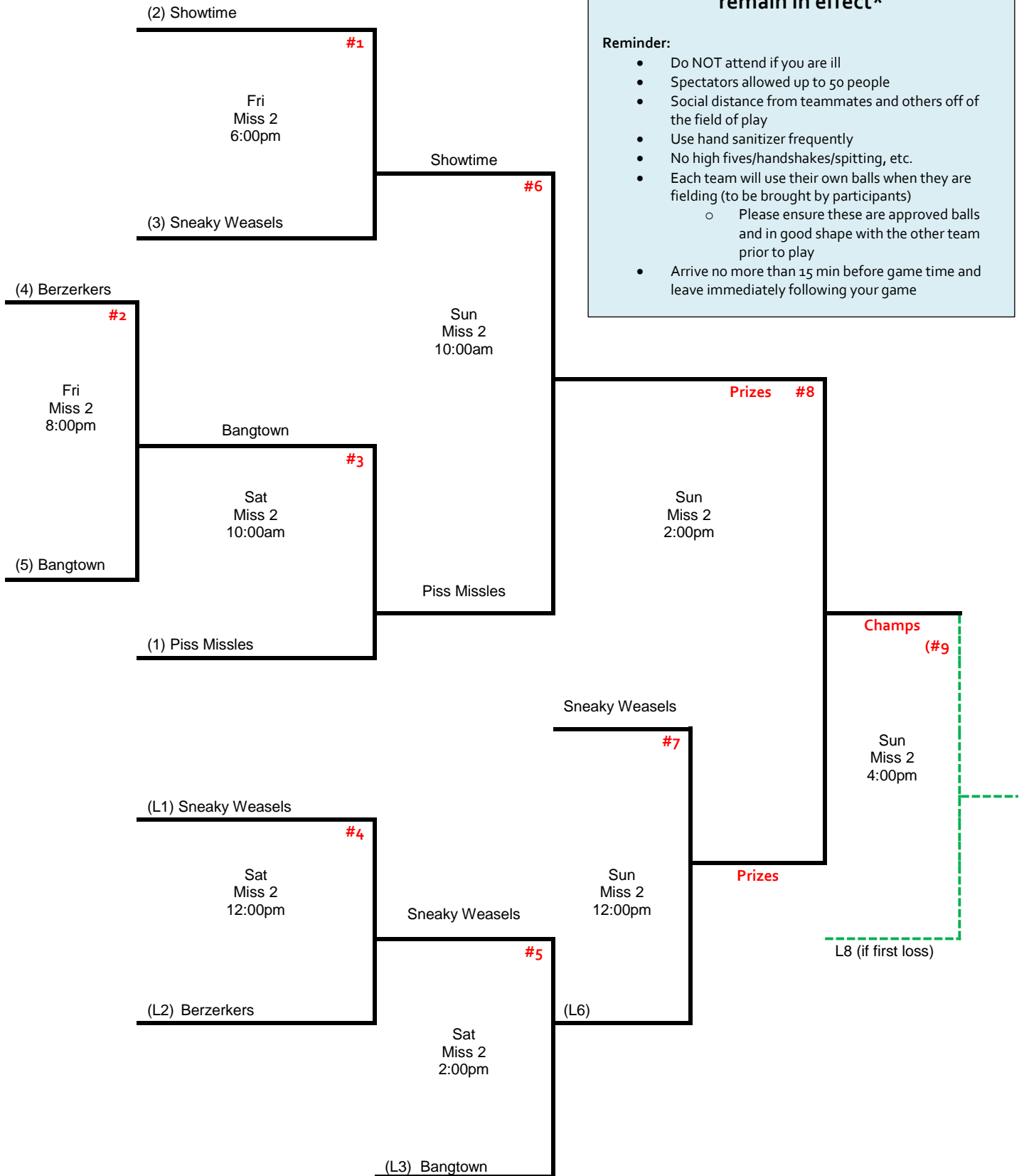

Teams disregarding the Slo-Pitch COVID Safety Guidelines will be withdrawn from playoffs

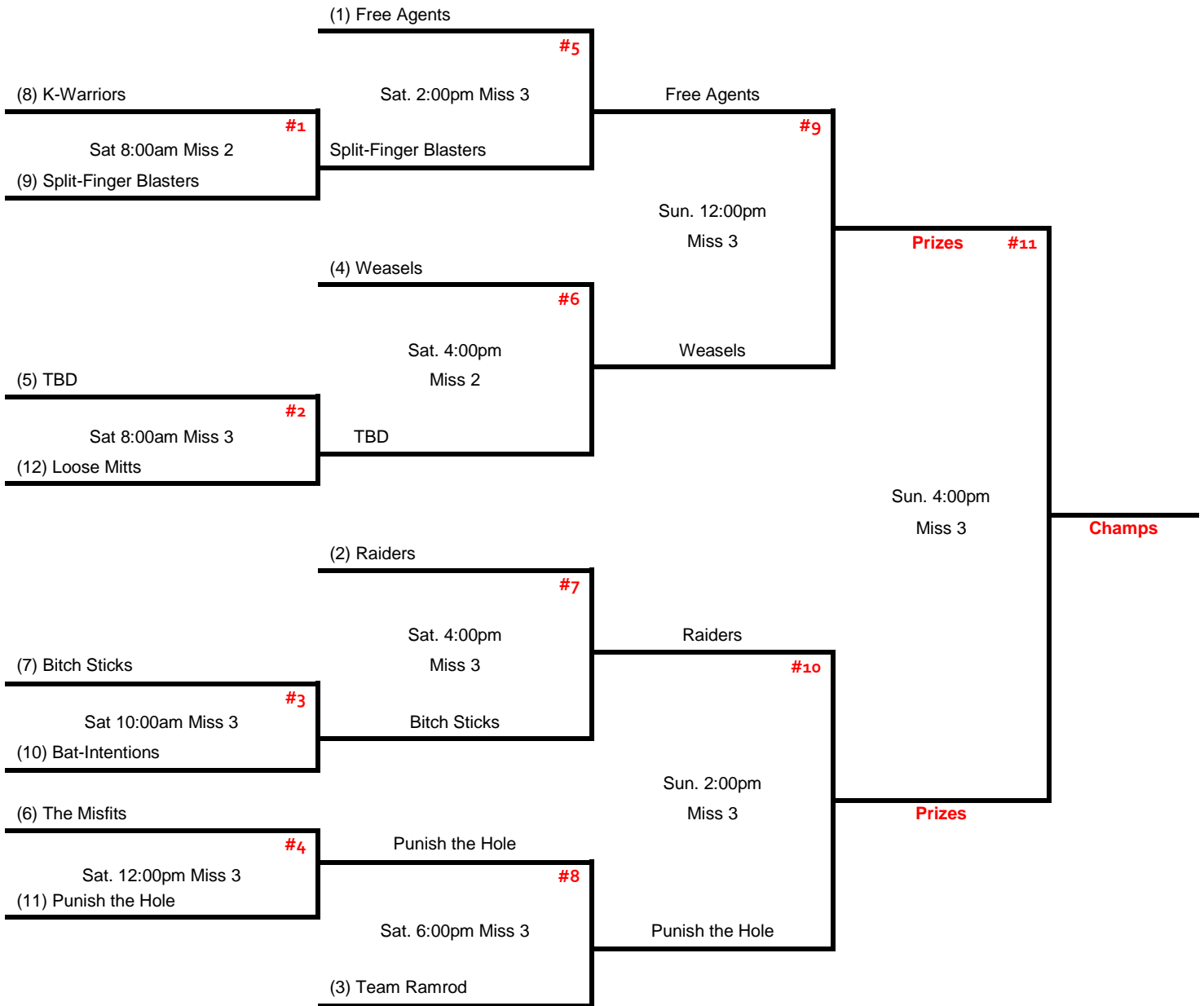
Playoff Format:

- All league and SPN (Slo-Pitch) rules apply.
- The team with the **higher ranking** (lower number in brackets) is the **home team**. The home team supplies the bases and strike mat (if necessary). Balls are provided by each team. Teams will ump their own batters as in league play. Umpires are supplied for semi-final and final games (plus all games for C division).
- Game time slots are **1 hour and 30 minutes** in length from **scheduled start time**. Games must keep to schedule.
- **No new innings are to start after 1 hr. 15 min. from scheduled start time. Between 65-75 minutes from the scheduled start time, if starting a new inning, this will be the "open" inning.**
- **5 run limit per inning**, with the last inning being the "Open Inning"
- **SPN "mercy rule – 12 runs" will be in effect for playoffs. (See SPN Rule Book).**
- **SPN "tie break / extra inning rule" in effect for playoffs. (See SPN Rule Book).**
- Teams will play against teams from other nights.
- Your league standing will determine which playoff division you will compete in the playoffs.
- Prizes are awarded to 1st and 2nd place in each playoff division.
- Teams found playing illegal players will be immediately withdrawn from playoffs.
- Teams not ready to play with the minimum amount of players (and bases; if they are required to supply them) by **10 minutes** past the scheduled start time will forfeit game.
- Should games be cancelled by the playoff coordinator due to unforeseen circumstances and are unable to be re-scheduled during the playoff tournament weekend, the higher ranking team will be awarded the win and move forward in the playoff tournament. If tournament cannot be completed due to unforeseen circumstances, final placement & prize distribution for each division will be based on the two highest ranking teams remaining in each division at the time of the tournament cancellation.
- **No outside alcohol permitted at Mission SB Complex. Teams found consuming alcohol at non-licensed city facilities will be withdrawn from the playoffs. Teams found bringing alcohol into licensed city facilities will also be withdrawn from playoffs.**

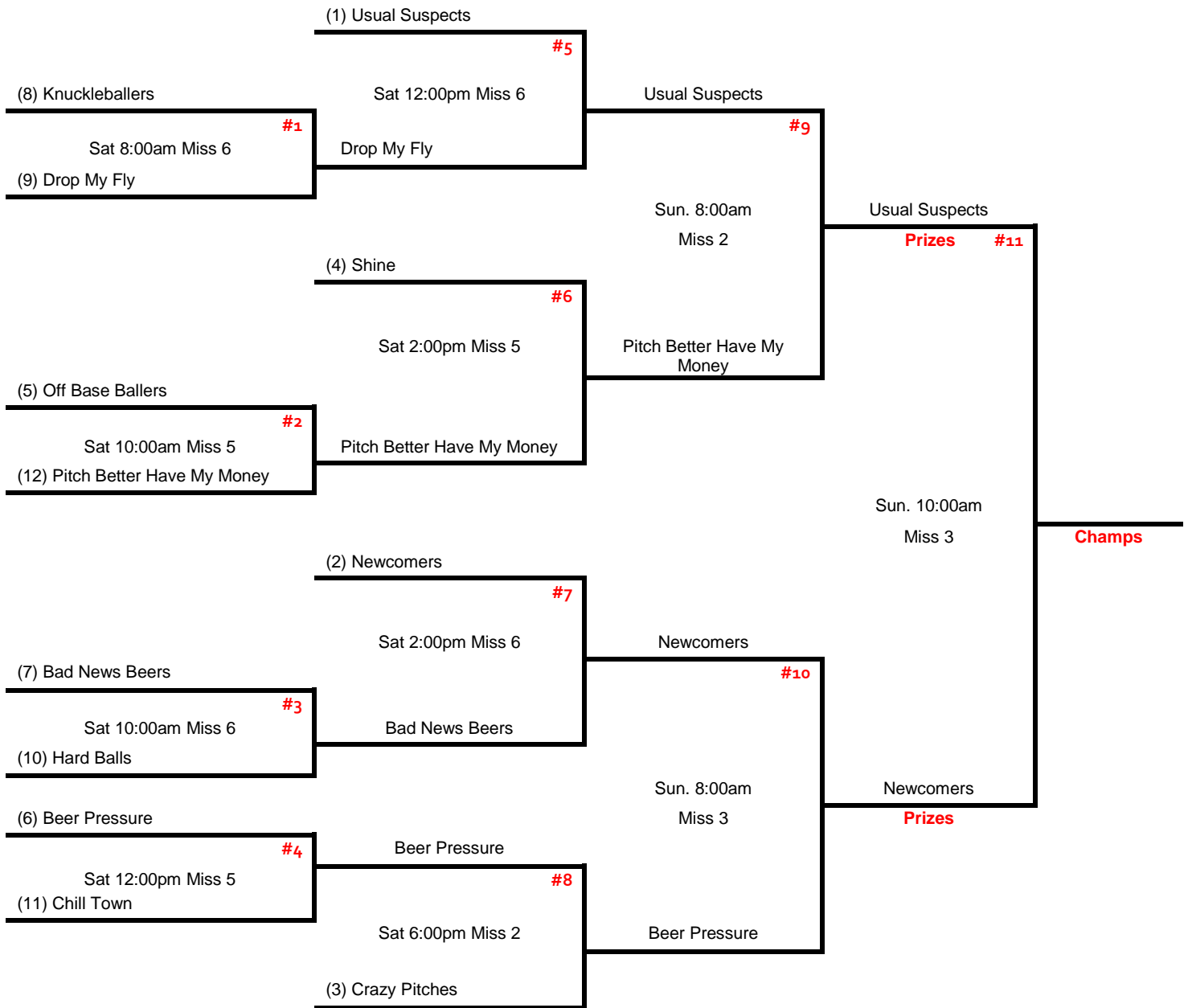

Co-ed "D-2" Intermediate Slo-Pitch

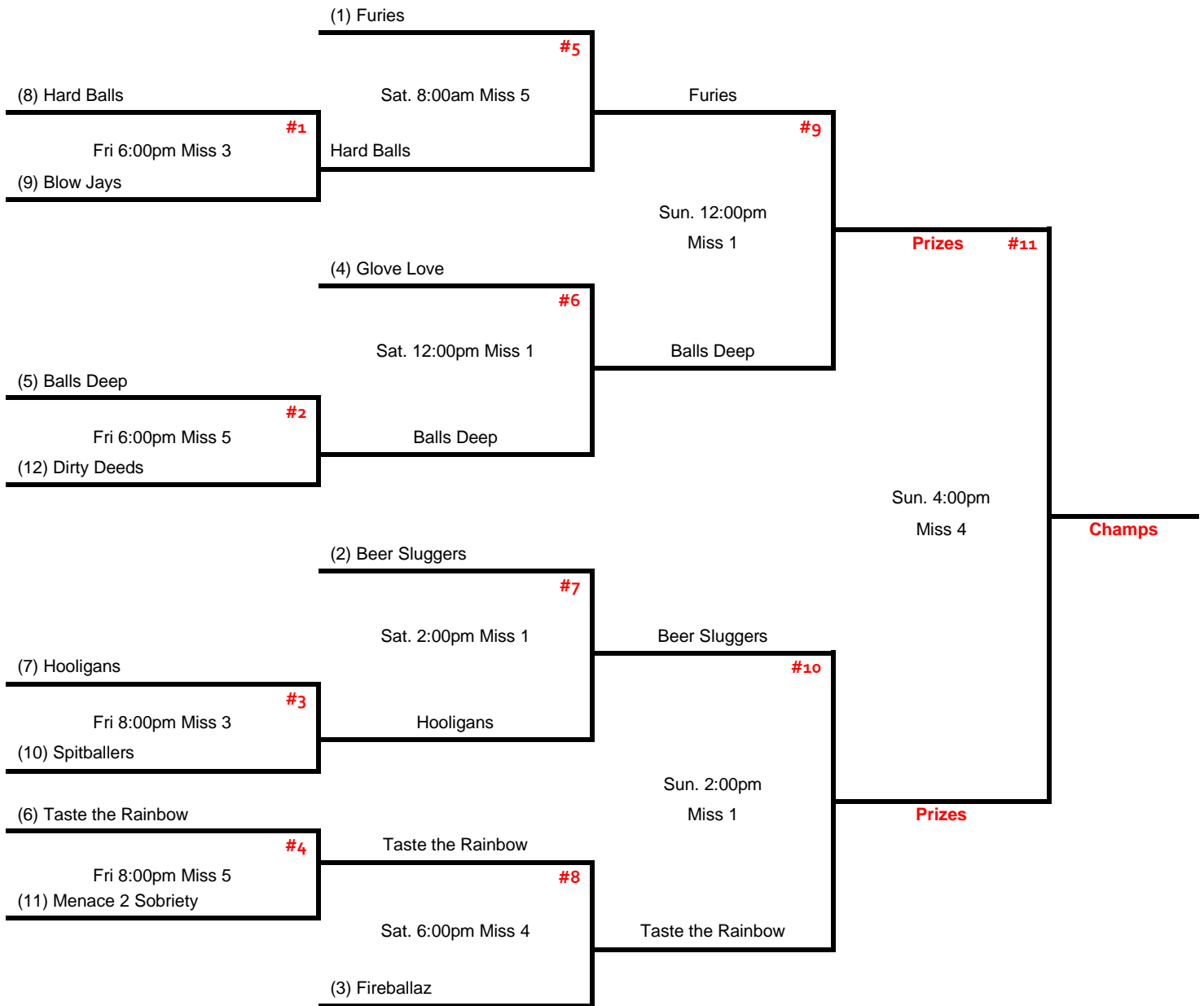

Co-ed "E-1" Intermediate Slo-Pitch

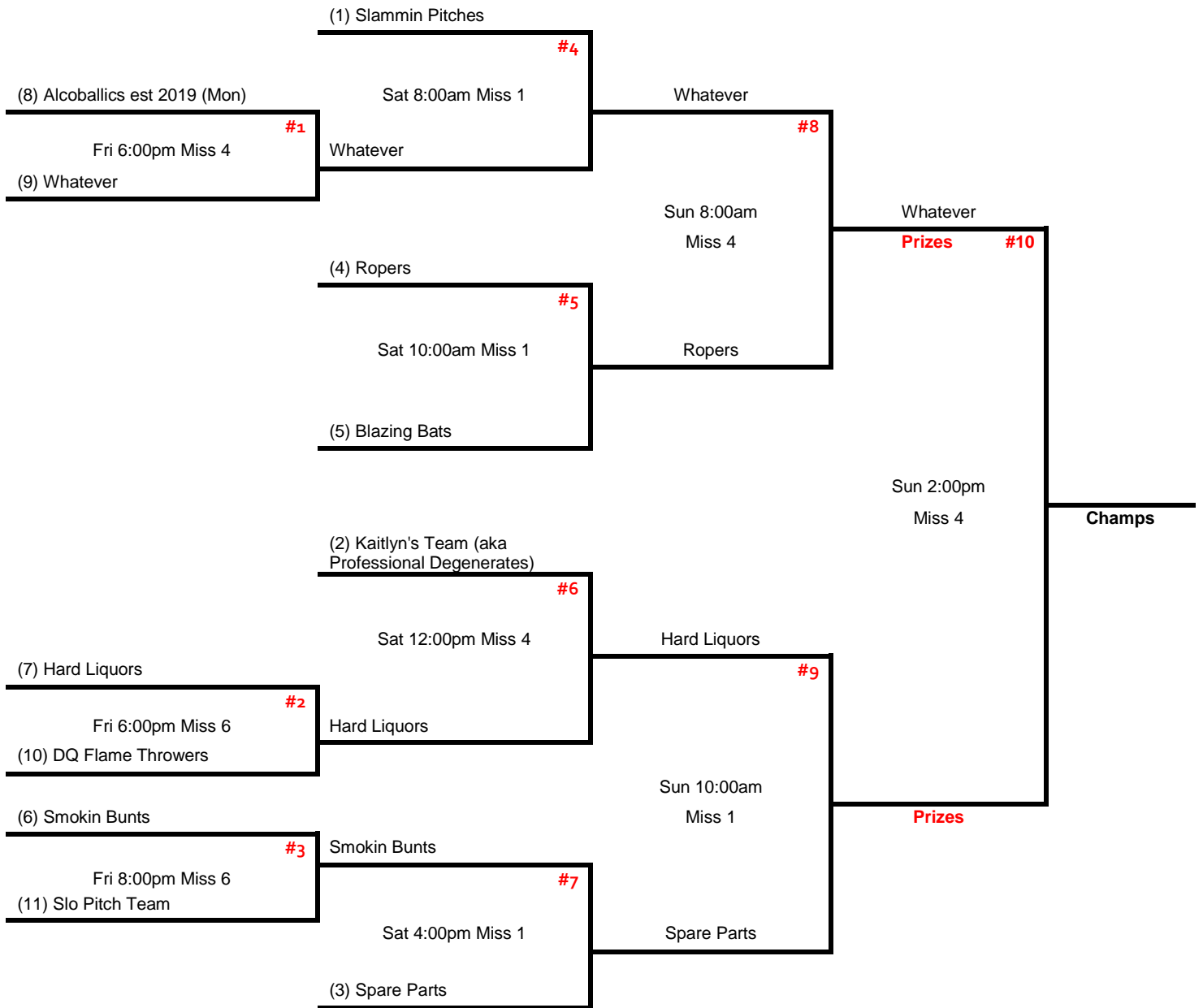

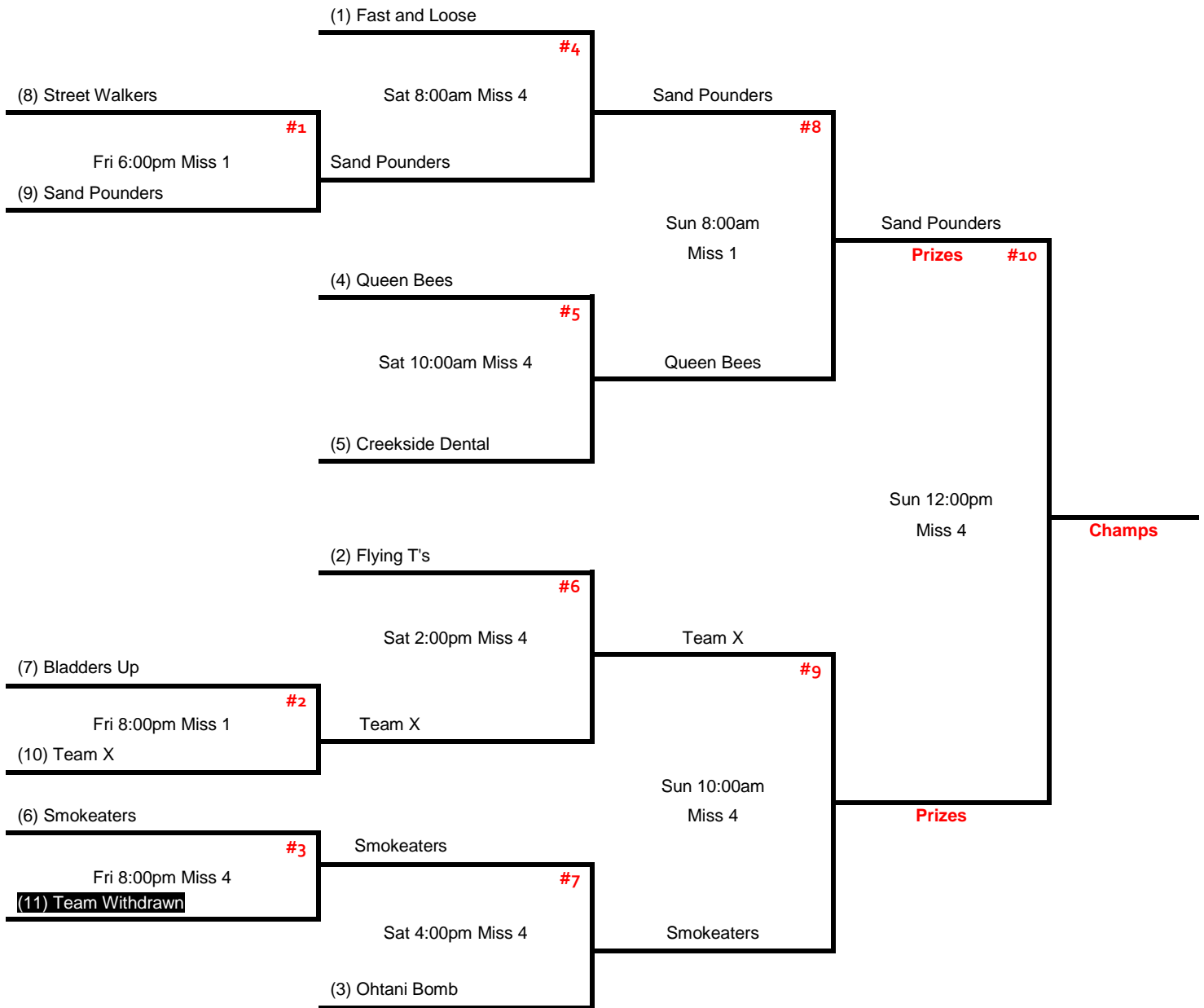
