## **League Rules Overview:**

- Both teams will supply their own game balls. 'C' level will use big ball (12") small ball (11") for male/female batters.
- Winning team to report scores to the Softball Score Line (250-469-8700) within 48 hours of the match completion. Please state the night and league, your team name and number, the name and number of the team you beat, and the score.
- 5 run rule per inning in effect with the last inning being "Open".
- 12 run "mercy rule" in effect.
- Teams may play with a minimum of 9 players (4 women & 5 men, or 5 women and 4 men) with an AUTOMATIC OUT.
- Rainouts will be decided at game time at the diamond. You must show up to your game. Do not assume it is cancelled. Teams will be contacted if diamonds are closed by the City.
- Teams defaulting 2 or more games will be eliminated from playoffs.

### Frequently Asked Rule Questions:

- When a male batter is walked, either intentionally or otherwise, and the next batter is female, the batter automatically goes to 2nd base, the next batter must bat.
- Runners can be tagged out between the commitment line and the scoring line.
- Home Run Rule – where an outfield fence is present:
  - “C” Level = 4 over the fence home runs per team per game
  - “D” Level = 2 over the fence home runs per team per game
  - “E” Level = 1 over the fence home run per team per game
    - An “over the fence” home run that exceeds this limit is an out.

### Reporting Results:

The winning team must report the match results to the Softball Score Line: 250-469-8700.

### Reporting Format:

Include the following: The Night and League, your Team Number and Name, the Number and Name of the team you beat, and the Score.

Example: Monday night 'D' Intermediate Slo-Pitch, Team 1 – Dodgers defeated Team 2 - Bluejays, 10 to 8.

### Point System:

Win = 3 pts	Loss = 0 pts	Tie = 2 pts each	Default = 0 pts	Unreported = 1pt each
Results must be reported accurately by the winning team within 48 hours to receive the 4 <sup>th</sup> 'win' point				
Default Rule – Teams defaulting and/or forfeiting 3 or more games will be disqualified for playoffs

### Roster Submission:

Roster submission are completed through SPN (slo-pitch.com).
