Bean Bag Toss Lawn Games League



OBJECT OF THE GAME

- The object of the game is to score 21 points before the other team.

PLAYING AREA

- Game field consists of a level outdoor space using bean bag toss set.
- Boards are spaced 27 feet from each other (approximately 11 paces).
- 4 same coloured bean bags per team.

PLAYERS

- Game can be played as a single or as doubles. (If playing doubles, partners alternate throwing each round).

RULES OF PLAY

- Players must not toss outside of the pitcher's box (the area to the side of the game board).
- Tosses must be underhand.
- Coin toss to determine who starts.
- Starting team will throw one of their bags, alternating team will throw one of their bags, alternating until all bags are thrown.
- Points will be tallied after everyone has thrown all of their bags.
- Throwing order is based on who scored last with the scorer throwing first. If no points are scored, previous throwing order is maintained.
- Bean bags can't bounce off the ground to score.

SCORING

- Bag in the hole = 3 points.
- Bag on the board = 1 point.
- Games go to 21 points. If overtime is required, teams must win by 2 points.
- Cancellation scoring is used (only one team can score per round).
 - Scoring Example:
 - Coin Toss: Team A wins.
 - Round 1: Team A scores 3 points, Team B scores 0 points. Team A would record 3 points.
 - Round 2: Team A scores 1 point, Team B scores 3 points. Team B would record 2 points.
 - After 2 rounds, Team A is winning 3-2. Team B would throw first next, as they were the last to score.
