

OBJECT OF THE GAME

- The object of the game is to score exactly 21 points before the other team.

PLAYING AREA

- Game field consists of a level outdoor space using game ladders.
- Game ladders are spaced 15 feet from each other (approximately 5 paces).
- 3 same coloured bolas (2 golf balls attached together) per team.

PLAYERS

- Game can be played as a single or as doubles. (If playing doubles, partners alternate throwing each round).

RULES OF PLAY

- Players are not allowed to toss in front of the ladder game. Tosses must be underhand.
- Coin toss to determine who starts.
- Starting team will throw all of their bolas, one at a time, towards to opposite game ladder.
- Next team will then do the same.
- Points will be tallied after everyone has thrown at the end of the round for the bolas remaining on the ladder.
- Throwing order is based on who scored last with the scorer throwing first. If no points are scored, previous throwing order is maintained.
- Bolas can bounce off the ground to score.

SCORING

- Top step = 3 points.
- Middle step = 2 points.
- Bottom step = 1 point.
- Bonus point: 1 point per round - All 3 bolas score in the same round. Highest points available per round is 10.
- Games go to exactly 21 points. If overtime is required, teams must win by 2 points. If a team scores above 21 points in the round they return to their previous score before the round began.
- Cancellation scoring is used (only one team can score per round).
 - Scoring Example:
 - Coin Toss: Team A wins.
 - Round 1: Team A scores 3 points, Team B scores 2 points. Team A would record 1 points.
 - Round 2: Team A scores 1 point, Team B scores 3 points. Team B would record 2 points.
 - After 2 rounds, Team B is winning 2-1. Team B would throw first next, as they were the last to score.
