Cremation Scattering

Garden and Trail Options

A scattering may only occur in designated areas within the Cemetery and only with an Interment Permit, issued from the Cemetery Office, complete with a scheduled date and time.

What is scattering?

Scattering cremated remains within the Cemetery is done on dedicated land that will always remain as an official, permanent interment area.

Scattering of cremated remains is available within the Promontory Green or at the base of Dilworth Mountain, adjacent to the nature trail. No personal items of any kind can be left on the bronze plaques or in the garden area and natural trail area. These areas must be left in their natural state.

- On each side of the garden, there is a memorial wall that provides an option to have a bronze memorial plaque mounted. One handful of cremated remains may be scattered amongst the trees and flowers. The remainder are placed in an Ossuary by the family following the scattering. These remains will become co-mingled as is customary. Booking: Scattering can be booked Mon-Fri from 9:30 am - 2:30 pm. Bookings must be made two business days in advance. Scatterings can be booked after 3 pm or Saturday for an additional fee.
- Dilworth Mountain Scattering Trail
The Cemetery offers a unique opportunity to scatter cremated remains anywhere along the 1/3 km nature trail at the foot of Dilworth Mountain. This beautiful, natural area offers views of the forest and the city. Stone pillars overlooking the city provide an option to have a bronze memorial plaque mounted. In this area, all the remains can be scattered along the trail.
Booking: seven days a week from 9:30 am until 2 hours before the park closes.
- Memorial Plaques Only - a memorial plaque can be purchased by anyone wishing to memorialize an individual that is not interred at the Kelowna Memorial Park Cemetery.
