### City Council

The City of Kelowna is governed by an elected council, a mayor and eight councillors, who are elected for fouryear terms. Each member of council represents the city at large.

Regular meetings are held Monday afternoons at 1:30 p.m. in Council Chambers at City Hall. During July and August these meetings are scheduled every two weeks. Public meetings on development applications are held once a month on Tuesdays at 4 p.m. Meetings are open to the public.

Kelowna City Council also meets on Monday mornings at 9 a.m. to discuss policy and governance issues, as well as in-camera business, as permitted under the Community Charter.
