

# Construction Noise Time Restriction Variance Application



City of Kelowna Good Neighbour Bylaw 11500, Section 8 prohibits Construction Noise on any day before 7:00 am or after 9:00 pm. Applications for variances to this time window must be submitted 5 Business Days prior the proposed activity and will be evaluated on the following criteria:

- The scope of the proposed work falls into an exemption category as outlined in Section 8.3,
- The applicant has demonstrated that the work cannot safely or practically be carried out during normal working hours,
- The applicant has proposed adequate mitigation measures for the noise, and
- The applicant has proposed adequate prior notification of affected neighbouring properties.
