

A generic list of known hazards to be taken into consideration for setup/takedown of outdoor events.
Hazards are not limited to those listed below.

Hazards	Potential Controls
Used Needles	Sweep area for needles, Used Needle Disposal Training & Kits, COK contact to come pick up if untrained
Insects (Ticks, Bees, Flies, Mosquitoes, etc)	Wear appropriate clothing, use repellents as necessary.
Thermal Stress (Cold & Heat)	Proper clothing, proper hydration (electrolytes, avoid caffeine), rest periods in shade or warm area dependent on hot or cold
Overhead Trees (Large Branches- Potential to break and fall)	Scan prior to work, alert COK of any questionable trees.
Uneven Terrain (Hills, paths, brush)	Awareness, proper footwear, walking stick, use built in rails and stairs, etc.
Small Ride On Engine- Equipment	ROPS, Training, Seat Belts, SWP's, PPE, Pre-Trip
Workplace Violence	Avoid, diffuse, defend, report via security reporting at CoK.
Noise	Working within exposure limits, hearing protection
Lifting & Carrying	Mechanical Assists, 2 person lift, bend at knees
Working at Heights (3 M/10ft)	Fall Protection Equipment, guardrails, training and certification
Utilities (Gas, power, water)	Contact Utility provider and/or COK to locate/ shut off, lock out/tag out
Poor Lighting	Flood worklights, flashlights, etc.
Slips & Trips	Proper footwear, environmental scan, good housekeeping
Power Tools	Training, follow manufacturer's specifications, engineered guards and PPE
Hand Tools	Training, follow manufacturer's specifications, engineered guards and PPE
Working Alone	Person Down Pendent, Means of Communication (2-Way, Cell, Walkie-Talkie), Check- Ins
First Aid Situation	Meet OHSR- FA Service Requirements, aware of the nearest hospital, medical walk in and aware of nearest City OFA II Site
Working with or around mobile equipment (eg. Backing up equipment)	Follow OHSR-follow manufacturers specifications, training and PPE
Ladders, Scaffolds and Work Platforms	Follow OHSR-proper ladders, CSA Approved, Scaffolds with all braces and proper PPE
Working Near Lake (Docks, Marina's, ponds, etc)	Proximity to edge, barriers to edge, PFD
Fecal Matter (Bird, rodent droppings)	Disinfecting procedure, ventilation, respiratory protection, PPE
Inclement Weather Events (Winds, Lightning, Thunderstorms, Hail, etc.)	Monitor Weather Advisories, Emergency Plan/Muster Point, Means of Communication
Aggressive Animals (Dogs, Raccoons, Marmots, Badgers, Bears, Cougars, Snakes)	Avoidance, barriers (broom handles, shovels, etc), Audible Deterrents (Bear Bells, Whistles, Loud Noises)
Traffic	TCP if needed, barricades, delineators, pylons, signage, PPE, Awareness of area
Playground Hazards (Pinch points, Sharp Edges, Slippery Surfaces, Children)	Playground Inspection Kits, PPE, Awareness of children
