


Taxi Hydrant Zone Pilot Program (2023)

The Taxi Hydrant Zone pilot program allows temporary taxi parking while waiting for a fare or to pick-up/drop-off passengers. These new Taxi Hydrant Zones are intended to utilize curb space in locations deemed appropriate. Six (6) Taxi Hydrant Zones have been designated in the Downtown and South Pandosy areas and are marked with clear signage.

Rules

- These zones may only be used by licensed and marked taxis. Rideshare vehicles are not permitted to use Taxi Hydrant Zones.
- Only designated Taxi Hydrant Zones with city-approved signage installed may be used. All other fire hydrant zones are excluded from the program.
- Taxi Drivers must remain with their vehicle at all times, except to aid in loading/unloading passengers. Any taxi found unoccupied in any of these zones may be ticketed and/or towed.
- Taxi Drivers must vacate the Taxi Hydrant Zone <u>immediately</u> upon the approach of an emergency vehicle.
- Taxi Drivers must obey the direction of Parking/Bylaw Enforcement, RCMP, or Fire Department.
- Locations may be added, removed, or adjusted as needed. It is the responsibility of drivers to check posted signage before use.
