

LAWN SWAP: GO ELECTRIC REBATE

The Regional Air Quality Program is a joint initiative of the City of Kelowna, the Regional District of Central Okanagan, the District of Peachland, the City of West Kelowna, Westbank First Nation, and the District of Lake Country. The Air Quality Program helps protect and improve the region's air through education, awareness, and pollution prevention programs.

The Air Quality program provides [Lawn Swap: Go Electric rebates](#) to Central Okanagan residents:

Central Okanagan residents may be eligible for a rebate when trading out old gas-powered equipment for new electric equipment. The rebate covers up to \$150 (no more than 50% of the cost) for new electric lawnmowers, leaf blowers, trimmers or chainsaws.

Rebates are granted on a first-come, first-served basis. Funding is limited and based on availability. Rebates will be paid by cheque and mailed to the address provided.

- One rebate per household.
- Gas-powered equipment being replaced must be recycled.
- The new electric equipment achieves **noise rating limits**.
