Kelowna residents and neighbourhood organizations may receive support through the Neighbourhood Event program for the following:

- Access a park under casual use guidelines
- Street or block closures for gatherings
- Event trailer, support staff, or the Meet Your Street Kit
- Advice on planning a Neighbourhood Event and neighbourhood connection

SN cannot support events that involve:

- Political or religious activities
- Alcohol
- Private, closed functions
- Events with an admission fee

Event Services

An Outdoor Event Permit is required to host events on City property if any of the following apply:

- Event details are deemed complex by Event Services
- Community wide event (promoted more widely than to the immediate neighborhood)
- Access to City services requested
- A liquor permit is requested for an event on City property
- Infrastructure required (portable toilets, temporary stages, greater than 10' x 10' tent, etc.)
- Event insurance liability questions
- Vendors will be present
- Inflatables not operated by the City of Kelowna will be present
